What Is a Medical Elective?

The medical elective is probably something that has been in the back of your mind since starting university and is often considered a major highlight of the medical school experience. It is a fantastic opportunity to spend around 8 weeks discovering medicine in a different environment, be it within your home town, or abroad. The elective is also an opportunity for you to distinguish yourself from your fellow students and increase your chances of getting a competitive job.

Choosing and planning the right elective for students can, therefore, be an exciting, yet daunting task. With so many elements to think about, it is difficult to know where to begin!



There are a number of choices to make with regards to electives: what to do and where to go. Some decide on the destination first and then think about what they want to do (specialty and whether mainly clinical or research). Others prefer to focus on the specialty/research interest first. You should make this decision based on what is most important to you and what type of experience you want to get out of your elective.

SUMS Medical Electives represent a unique opportunity for medical students, allowing them to experience health care in a setting unfamiliar to that in which they are accustomed to studying. 

In order to be eligible to apply for SUMS Medical Elective Programs, the applicant is required to satisfy the succeeding requisites prior to commencement of the application procedure:

The candidate must be a medical student.

The candidate should not be a graduate.

The candidate must be in their final or penultimate year of study of their medical degree, as students are expected to have done some clinical training before they can undertake an elective placement at SUMS.

The candidate must be a non-Iranian or Iranian student enrolled in a non-Iranian university, or be an international student studying in an Iranian university.

When to Apply

SUMS call for application to Medical Elective Programs is open all year round. However, candidates are highly recommended to apply at least 6 to 8 months prior to the commencement of the program in order to avoid late visa issues.

Admission Requirements

The online application will prompt you to upload a scanned version of the following documents:

Medical Elective Application Form (prospective applicants should fill out the Medical Elective Application Form and get it signed and stamped by the institution at which they are conducting study.)







Passport photograph



Scanned copy of data page of valid passport



Transcript of the records/Marksheets

Curriculum Vitae (CV)/Résumé





The applicants must fulfill one of the following language proficiency requirements:



TOEFL: a minimum score of 69 iBT; 525 PBT



IELTS: a minimum band score of 5.5



Other evidence showing that the applicant has English language proficiency at least equivalent to the above requirements

However, the applicants who are native speakers of English or who have received their education in a university where English is the primary medium of instruction as well as those who know Persian are exempted from this requirement. It is worth noting that since candidates are exposed to a setting in which interaction between doctors and patients is in Persian, knowing the Persian language can be an advantage.







It's a challenge, but a rewarding one. Expand your horizons and gain considerable expertise in medicine through a worthwhile elective placement abroad, which can be tailor-made to suit your interests and requirements. Begin your future career in the healthcare field with a new skillset and a broader knowledge of global medical issues.

Visa Application:

Upon receipt of your admission, you are requested to submit the following items to SUMS via e-mail so that your visa application procedure will commence:


Color passport photograph (3*4 cm or 4*6 cm in size)
Scanned copy of data page of valid passport

Completed SUMS Visa Application Form

Visa process may take at least between 10-12 weeks to complete. Each successful application is assigned a reference number/authorization code by the Iranian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. You will need the reference number/authorization code along with your original passport to collect your visa. Once we receive the visa reference number/authorization code, we will forward it to you via email. Then, you should schedule an appointment with the Iranian Embassy or Consulate in the country that you have already indicated on your visa application form. Carry the obtained visa reference number/authorization code together with your passport to the relevant embassy or consulate to collect your visa.
