SUMS Bachelor's Program is a post-secondary (post-high school) degree awarded to an individual after completion of undergraduate course work usually taking eight semesters to complete. Course work for bachelor's degrees is done at the undergraduate level and is made up of general studies and major specific classes. To further education and career advancement, SUMS offers international Bachelor's students 13 disciplines across its 17 schools.

Length of Training

Typically, SUMS Bachelor's Degree Programs require four years of full-time study. The academic year normally runs for nine months, with two semesters per year.

Medium of Instruction

The main medium of instruction for SUMS Bachelor's Programs tends to be Persian. However, based on the number of applicants for a specific program and availability of resources, some programs might also be offered in the English language. Hence, applicants are highly recommended to contact us before applying for their program of interest.

Persian Language Requirements

For programs that are held in the Persian language, SUMS requires all applicants to demonstrate competence in the Persian language at a very high level before beginning their proposed course of study. Applicants who are not familiar with the Persian language must attend SUMS Persian courses for at least a year prior to commencement of their program. Please note that the University reserves the right to request any applicant to sit for a Persian Proficiency test or to undertake an Academic Persian Bridging program as a condition of their offer.

Proof of Proficiency Not Required

Normally, if you meet any one of the following conditions you are not required to submit proof of proficiency in Persian:

- Mother tongue (language first learned and still used on a daily basis) is Persian.
- Has obtained (or is about to obtain) a secondary/tertiary degree from a recognized foreign institution where Persian is the language of instruction.
- Has obtained (or is about to obtain) a degree from a recognized institution in Iran.
- Has lived and attended high school/university, or been employed, for at least four consecutive years, in a country where Persian is the acknowledged primary language.

Prospective applicants can apply all year round. However, it is highly recommended to submit the requisite documents 6 months prior to the commencement of the intended semester as at least a period of 2 months for admission procedures and 10-12 weeks to avoid late visa issues are required.
